Irrigation Auditor Certification Course

The Florida Irrigation Society certification course is recommended for contractors wishing to improve their system evaluation skills, government inspectors enforcing new irrigation codes, mobile irrigation lab operators, and consultants interested in providing auditing services to local utilities.

This course is approved for 14 General CEU's in Volusia, Lake, and Pinellas Counties.

Familiarity with irrigation system design, installation, maintenance and management is a recommended prerequisite for taking this course. A minimum of three years experience is recommended.

Day one will cover report writing, common irrigation components, hydraulics, application rates, soils, plant water requirements and the levels of evaluations.

Day two be prepared to get wet as students obtain hands-on experience by collecting field data, making recommendations for improving the system and calculating before and after water use. **A certification exam will be given upon completion of the fieldwork and is required to receive both the CEU'S and the certification.**
