Site Manager Certification Course

Water conservation is becoming increasingly important for any person involved in managing irrigation systems. This renewed emphasis on water management requires irrigation technicians, landscapers, and facility managers improve their irrigation management skills.

The Irrigation Site Manager course is an introduction to the principles of operation and management of irrigation systems, specifically as applied to operating costs and water efficiency. The course will cover basic irrigation components, sprinkler performance, obtaining site information, developing maintenance procedures, distribution systems, control systems, codes and standards.

This course is approved for 8 CEU's in Volusia, Lake, Pinellas, and Dade.

- Irrigation contractors who want to improve their understanding of water conservation.
- Irrigation technicians who maintain systems.
- Irrigation workers seeking to improve their skills.
- Landscapers who maintain sites.

- Water conservation professionals who wish to understand irrigation and methods for conserving water.
